That will be an act of courteous expression of esteem, sympathy and regard for the victims in the form of public display, or few words to be said with heartfelt emotions that could bring a ray of hope into the darkened life of the families at loss. It is sincerely hoped that all of us will pass the word or forward this message to all our contacts to the effect that all of us Eritreans get informed and fulfill our duties through the desired participation, as the least we could do for our loved ones.

As we scored high during the Candle Vigil of October 8, 2013, once again, we need to prove to our people that we are not less concerned or less sympathetic than our Eritrean counterparts in other parts of the world. It is through such functions that we prove to ourselves and to others that all Eritreans, irrespective of all social distinctions (be it political, cultural, religious, ethnic ...etc), constitute ONE BIG FAMILY that sneezes when any of its integral parts catches cold.
