

News from Ancestral land of Eritrean Kunama

A deadly round up is scheduled for 29/10/2014 in Eritrea at a national level, our insiders disclosed. In line to this, the Eritrean regime has commenced of detaining civilians and charging them for no crime committed by them. Ten kunama and two more Eritreans from Tigre speakers who are residents of Tessenei and its vicinities were detained on 20/09/2014. Those detained and still remained untraced 12 Eritreans are

1. Hamed Osman Mohamed- Kunama and vice administrator of that vicinity,
2. Kamis Adum- Kunama
3. Mohamed Osman-Kunama
4. Adum seleman-Kunma
5. Asan Osman-Kunama
6. Gurida Isa-kunama
7. Asan bakin- Kunama
8. Daude Galla-Kunama from Asa galla village
9. Daynab Šhamail – Kunama
10. Bariyam karar-Kunama
11. Umad Adum karar-Tigre and
12. Ibrahim Umad from Tigre ethnic group.

On top of this, five innocent Kunama youths, who are residents of Taykanabo village were forcibly conscripted, headed and imprisoned in Shakat for short period and now transferred to Barentu. Names of those detained youths are,

1. Abebe nase
2. Butu Luguse
3. Naja Ali
4. Dalle Awate and
5. Nyanga Koday. They were detained on 17/09/2014. In a similar way and on 09/10/2014 four women and a man from Asmara were caught and detained in Barentu while they were crossing to Ethiopia. The source of all irregularities, detention and suppression being the regime in post, the international community with especial reference to the newly established commission of inquiry should do its level best to trace the whereabouts of these innocents citizens recently detained in various prison cells and locations.
